## **The Adventure Programme conditions**

**In order to ensure that your child gets the best possible experience from Adventure day activities we ask that you spend a few moments looking over the conditions and then sign the parent/guardian agreement section at the bottom of the page. Thank you for your co-operation and support.**

- In the interest of child safety participants must be signed in/out by parent/ guardian unless otherwise indicated on the booking form.
- If you do consent for your child to arrive/ leave The Depot on their own, please understand that The Depot staff does not have responsibility for your child should they wish to leave the facility on their own.
- Participants may arrive from 8:45am and activities will commence at 9:30am. Activities will finish at 4pm and participants should be picked up by 4.30pm.
- We ask that these participants remain on site throughout their stay.
- All participants must agree to and obey to The Depot code of conduct.
- The Depot staff reserve the right to exclude individuals who break that conduct code and will expect them to be removed from the premises. We kindly ask for parent/guardian support in this matter.
- Mobile phones/MP3 players/Games consoles will not be permitted during activity sessions (A safe box locked in the office will be provided for storage during activity sessions). This is to reduce distractions and damages during activities.
- Use of the Skate park is allowed during Depot time and it is strongly recommended that safety gear is worn at all times especially helmets.
- It is the responsibility of participants to look after their own personal property and lockers are available. The Depot can not be held responsible for theft or damage.
- We strongly recommend that expensive media players/equipment is left at home.
